

Spring Park Spring Clean Up Day

Saturday, May 6, 2023

THIS CLEAN UP IS FOR SPRING PARK RESIDENTS AND APARTMENTS ONLY

(Apartment tenants should contact their leasing office for further details)

Items must be bagged, boxed or bundled and at curbside by 7 a.m. Items for pick up can be placed curbside no more than 7 days prior to Clean Up Day or an administrative fine will be issued. Moisture absorbent materials such as upholstered items must be protected from the elements. If any acceptable items are accidentally missed by the trucks on Clean Up Day, residents should notify City Hall within 3 days, or the items will need to be removed at the expense of the property owner.

Accepted for pick-up:

- Small furniture (loveseats, chairs, couches)
- Mattresses
- Clothing
- Grills, toilets, sinks, etc.
- Appliances (microwaves, a/c units, washers, dryers)
- Refrigerators & freezers (must have doors removed)
- Computers, printers, TV's
- Brush, limbs, tree or shrub trimmings that are BUNDLED (limbs no larger than 1" in diameter & less than 4-foot lengths)
- Tires (passenger vehicle size only)
- Carpet (must be tied and bundled in 4-foot lengths)
- Leaves—bagged in paper leaf bags (leaves are picked up separately so please do not mix leaf bags with other bags)

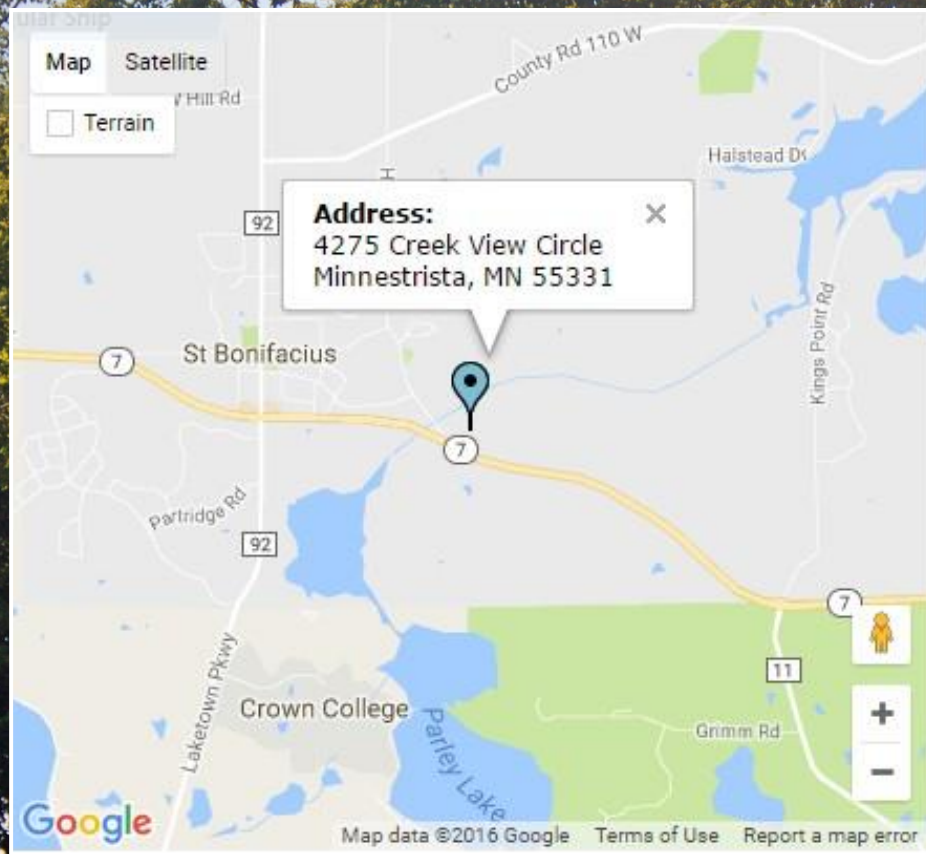
NOT accepted for pick-up:

- Recyclable glass, cans, paper, plastic (save for your normal recycling day)
- Garbage or regular household trash
- Stumps, logs, concrete, rocks, railroad ties
- Building materials in quantities over 1 cubic yard
- Docks, dock parts, and dock lifts
- Derelict vehicles or large auto parts
- Hazardous waste: chemicals, automotive oil, batteries, fuel tanks or paint, fluorescent light bulbs, etc. (Bring to County Drop Off Site 612-348-3777)

The Mulch Store

The City contracts with The Mulch Store to provide residents with a yard waste drop-off site located in Minnetrista. The Mulch Store is traditionally open April 1 until Thanksgiving, if weather allows. There is no cost to use the site, although a form of identification showing that you are a resident of Spring Park will be required by site staff.

Allowable materials include leaves, garden waste, weeds, milfoil, grass clippings, and brush.
